**3-2. Describe how the CoC determined that this project should be eliminated and include the date the project applicant was notified. (limit 2500 characters)**

The Texas Balance of State Continuum of Care (TX BoS CoC) Board followed the process outlined in the "Reallocation Policy for Continuum of Care Program Funds in the Texas Balance of State Continuum of Care" when making the decision about this project. The Board considered pertinent information related to the Agency's history and performance, HUD monitoring, Quality Review Plan (QRP) progress, participant outcomes, timely submissions of APRs, HMIS data quality, the validity of disclosure in prior competitive processes, and mitigating information submitted by the organization for consideration, including support from the community.

It was determined that the Agency omitted pertinent information about the Organization during the FY2023 Competition. When this determination was made, it was too late to reallocate this project in FY2023. CoC Staff contacted SNAPS to disclose the omission, and other relevant details, but the project was selected for conditional award despite this action.

FY24 was the first opportunity following the omission available for the CoC to reallocate this project.

The project was subject to TX BoS CoC's Conditional Inclusion policy for two consecutive CoC Program Competitions due to being the lowest scoring project of the Joint Transitional Housing/Rapid Re-Housing component type in both Competition cycles. Per the Conditional Inclusion policy, projects conditionally included will develop a QRP to address performance issues. This plan is made by project staff with the CoC, and project staff meet monthly with CoC staff to review progress and update.

The project applicant was also subject to Reallocation due to chronic underspending. Applicant returned more than 10% of grant funds to HUD for the last two completed operating years.

In the FY2022 CoC Program Competition, Applicant's Transitional Housing data reflected a 100% error rate for missing Annual Assessments. While the Rapid Rehousing component reflected zero missing Annual Assessments, this outcome was due to not having any participants enrolled in the RRH portion of the project at any point during the evaluation period. In the FY2023 Competition, TH data reflected a 0% missing Annual Assessment error rate for this component, and RRH data reflected a 100% missing Annual Assessment error rate.

The project applicant was notified about the Reallocation on June 5, 2024.
